In February we aim to teach the children the following safety skills without giving explicit information. Teaching them how to stay safe by learning the PANTS rules, which the NSPCC have developed to be like the Green Cross Code for staying safe.

- P: Privates are private
- A: Always remember your body belongs to you
- N: No means no
- T: Talks about secrets that upset you
- S: Speak up, someone can help
